The time has passed so quickly. Many of you appear to have navigated the years without much trouble. For some of you, however, the years have been challenging and sometimes unforgiving. Finding a New Doctor

Unfortunately our group's efforts to find replacement physicians has been unsuccessful. I suggest the following to find a new doctor for yourself:

- 1. Ask family and friends if they can try to get you in with their doctor.
- 2. Visit https://www.healthlinkbc.ca/ or call 8-1-1 (7-1-1 for hearing impaired)
- 3. Contact **RSRS** (see below). They often are aware of physicians accepting new patients.

In the event of a medical emergency, patients are instructed to go to the nearest hospital emergency room.

Your Medical Record - IMPORTANT

I am required by the College of Physicians & Surgeons to store all original patient records for a period before they can be destroyed. I have selected **RSRS**, a physician-managed company to safely and securely store all patient records from the clinic, and to assist you in **obtaining a** *certified copy* for **yourself**. Requests for your records from a new physician's office can be faxed in to RSRS at 1-877-398-5932 or emailed to info@rsrs.com

It is strongly recommended that you obtain a certified copy of your personal medical history from <u>RSRS.</u> It is a very important file for your continued care and should be accessible at all times, **especially during these times and in the absence of a new doctor**. I have included an infographic illustrating 10 reasons why the record is so important. While there is a fee for the copy/transfer of medical records, it is not prohibitive.
